Ukraine – Russia Conflict

1. We have no direct or indirect operations or sub-suppliers in the Ukraine, Russia and/or Belarus. That means, there is no actual or expected impacts on our business.
2. There are no logistics routes of products supplied to you affected by the conflict, Only the prices of some products (Nickel, Palladium, Energy) are much higher than 6 months before.
3. Today we expect no negative effects on our ability to supply our customers. (exports controls, tariffs, sanctions or embargos)
4. We have preventive measures in place allowing for enhanced data/cyber security and measures to mitigate against connectivity risks. We work with the very secure IBM AS 400 system.
5. We started a question campaign for our subcontractors, by our own suppliers regarding the above-mentioned aspects. Until now, there are no critical feedbacks.
6. Today there are no additional challenges arising from the situation that might impact your ability to reliably supply our customers.

We stay in close contact with our suppliers and you as customer, so we can navigate through this together.
